Dear Parents and Carers,

At last the summer has arrived and the children are enjoying the sunshine! Please remember to put sun protection on your child before they come to school in order to avoid the risk of sunburn. This term is a very busy term and we have many exciting events and trips for the children to look forward to, so please keep checking our website for updates. The school photographer will be in school on Tuesday 10th May. **SATs testing for the children in year 2 starts on Tuesday 10th May** and ends on Thursday 19th May. Please make sure your children attend school every day on time, get plenty of rest and lots of encouragement.

New school office. We are now carrying out the last stage of our school improvement works at the front of the school. This involves building a new school office with sliding doors to make our entrance accessible to all. We are anticipating that this office will be finished by the end of the summer term ready for our new children and their families in September. The office will feature a much better space for when parents or carers are waiting to speak to office staff and IT access for those parents and carers who need to carry out some online enquiries related to the school—for instance when completing 'E-Admissions' via the council. This is another example of the improvements we have been able to make as part of our partnership with the Pegasus Academy Trust making things better for families in this part of Croydon.

Before school in the reception and Year 1 playground. Our playgrounds have now been fully refurbished and look fantastic but we need to ask parents and carers to help us with some organisation please. There are signs in the bike area saying that the play bikes are not to be used before or after school and we ask that families respect this and stop their children, including younger siblings, from playing with the bikes, or indeed the other equipment that has been set out for the day ahead. Staff prepare these spaces before school and it is frustrating to come out and find the activities they have prepared in a mess. Children may play on climbing frames, with adult supervision, but please support us by stopping them playing with the bikes or other activities.
