Consulting you on a proposal to expand Whitehorse Manor Junior School

Wednesday 24th April to Wednesday 19th June

The school

Whitehorse Manor Junior School is located on Whitehorse Road, Thornton Heath, CR7 8SB. The school normally admits 3 classes, being 90 Year 3 pupils per year. This document sets out a proposal to make places available for another 30 children per year on a separate site.

Why does Croydon need more primary school places?

Like most London Boroughs, Croydon is facing an unprecedented growth in demand for places. This is driven by:

- An increase in the number of births by over 31% in the period from 2001 to 2011;
- An increase in the proportion of those born in the borough who need school places five years later. In 2012, 95% of the number born five years earlier came forward for school places. This is an increase of 6% since 2010;
- A continuing flow of population from inner London to the outer London boroughs and a decrease due to the housing market in those moving the other way;

Put simply, there are more children and more of them are staying in Croydon. This is particularly the case in the area where Whitehorse Manor is located.

Why are we proposing to expand Whitehorse Manor Junior School?

Enlarging a school is an exciting but challenging task. Croydon Local Authority have approached the Pegasus Academy Trust to join them in a partnership to provide extra school places in this part of the borough. We have considered:

- The popularity and success of Whitehorse Manor Junior School;
- Leadership capacity to ensure that high quality places will be made available;
- The suitability of a new site on Brigstock Road;
- The location close to areas of high demand;
- Value for money.

Whitehorse Manor Junior School is a popular school with good leadership and governance. The Pegasus Academy Trust have demonstrated that they can successfully operate a multi site group of schools, as evidenced by their work with Ecclesbourne Primary School. For 2013 admission the Trust received 494 applications for the 90 reception places available at Whitehorse Manor Infant School. These children automatically transfer to Whitehorse Manor Junior School on reaching Year 3 age

How would the expansion happen?

If the proposal goes ahead 120 places will be offered to children applying for reception places in September 2013 using the school's normal admissions arrangements. We propose to open a **new annexe of the school at a site on Brigstock Road** which will have all the facilities necessary to accommodate these extra children. We are working with Croydon Council who will build the new facility which will then be operated by the Trust.

The Trust will receive additional funding to employ extra staff and meet the other extra costs associated with the additional children in the new building. Croydon Council is funding the building costs for the new annexe and will sign a development agreement with the Trust stating what facilities will be provided in the new building. As with all the facilities in the Trust, we are looking forward to high quality learning spaces and facilities that meet the needs of the local community. The school would continue to receive an additional class in reception each year, so that by 2019 the school would have an extra 210 pupils in total, with 120 children in every year group.

What happens after the consultation?

All the feedback we receive will be collated and reported to the Directors of The Pegasus Academy Trust. The Directors of The Pegasus Academy Trust will make a decision on whether to go ahead, taking account of the pressure on primary places and the consultation feedback. If a decision is made to go ahead The Directors will then apply to the Secretary of State for approval of the expansion scheme.
