

At Ecclesbourne we offer childcare facilities for children before and after school.

## Our pledge to parents and carers

We value our relationship with parents and carers at Ecclesbourne Primary School and are committed to working in partnership with you to provide high quality play and care for your children. We work within a framework which insures equality of opportunity, providing a safe, secure and stimulating environment for all children and families.

When dealing with parents and carers we:

- welcome you at all times to discuss our work, have a chat or take part in our activities;
- keep you informed of opening times, fees and charges, programmes of activities, menus and procedures;
- be consistent and reliable to enable you to plan with confidence and peace of mind;
- share and discuss your child's achievements, experiences, progress and friendships;
- ask your permission for special events;
- listen to your views and concerns to ensure we continue to meet your needs.

## Before school

Based in the dining hall, our breakfast club is open from 7:45 am and costs £3.00 per day. Parents and carers can drop off their children and leave them in safe hands. We provide a choice of cereal, toast, yoghurt, fruit and a drink. A range of activities is on offer.

Children who attend the breakfast club are escorted to their classes at 8:55am.

## After school

Our after school club, based in the dining hall, runs from 3:15pm until 6:00pm each evening during term time. At 4:30pm we provide a light tea such as pasta, jacket potato or sandwiches with a drink.

There is a range of activities for the children such as arts and crafts, games and sport.

The cost is £9.00 for the session.

Children may be collected from the hall up until 6:00pm.
