Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! It is lovely to see all of our pupils again after the summer holidays, looking well-rested and ready to get back to learning. I am excited about the year ahead and looking forward to building on last year's successes and further improving Ecclesbourne for your children. There are, as always, lots of exciting things planned for the year ahead. Our teachers and team leaders have been busily planning an assortment of educational visits to enhance our curriculum and Mrs Christopher is making sure our afterschool clubs are of the highest quality. Starting the day well: As ever, we will be keeping a close watch on attendance and punctuality. Last year, overall attendance at the school was 96.1% and although this is above the government target of 95% there is still room for improvement. Being in school every day gives your child the consistency they need to support their learning. Similarly, we want all the children to have the best possible start to the school day. The doors open at 8.45am and teachers have various types of early work available in class from this time. It is a really good idea to aim to get your child into class by 8.45am, as this ensures that they are never late for school and they are calm and settled when they begin the day. Take advantage of this, and your child will benefit from an extra 1 ½ hours of learning a week.

Jeans for Genes Day/ MacMillan Coffee Morning: This year, on Friday 18th September, we will be supporting the charity event 'Jeans for Genes'. This is a national event that encourages people to wear their jeans to work or school for a small donation. The money goes to support the charity in its valuable work supporting children with genetic disorders. <u>Cashless Trips:</u> This year, in an effort to reduce the risk of having large amounts of cash on the school premises, we will be moving towards a system where all trips will be paid for using the Parent Pay system. This will mean that you will no longer have to send your child in with cash and will be able to pay for trips by simply going on line or visiting one of the many Pay Points in local shops. We hope that this will make things easier and safer for parents.
