Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a busy start to the term but the children have all settled well into their new classes and made a good start to the year. It has been good to get to know some of you and your children and I look forward to meeting more of you, in time.

<u>Meet the New Staff</u> There are many new faces in the school and within Pegasus Trust so we would like to invite parents in to meet people and get to know who's who. We will be hosting a drop in session on Wednesday 26th September from 8:45am. Please feel free to drop in for a cup of tea and a biscuit, to get to know the new staff. Later in the term we will host an alternative session, after school, for those of you who can't make the morning session.

Punctuality and Attendance As ever, we are keeping a close eye on attendance at the school and working closely with our Education Welfare Service, to make sure that children are in school. Currently attendance is running at 95.7% which is below OFSTED's expectation of 96%. Well done to Shooting Stars class who have had 100% attendance for the last two weeks. It is worth noting that two local parents were recently fined £700 each, for failure to pay a fixed penalty for poor school attendance. We are also closely monitoring punctuality. **So far there have been over 100 incidences of lateness.** The gates close at 9:00am; after this time children will need to enter past the office and collect a late mark.

Parent View I am very keen to gauge the opinions of parents about the school and find out what we can do to improve. OFSTED are also very keen to take into account the views of parents. To this end, they have created a website called Parent View (www.parentview.ofsted.gov.uk) that allows parents to give their views, through a very quick survey. There is a link on our website to the site and I would appreciate any feedback that you would like to give.
