Dear Parents and Carers.

New uniform opportunities: We are keen to encourage our children to look smart for school, and thank parents for ensuring that their children are properly attired each day. From the new year there will be two new items of uniform available. A black 'Pegasus' baseball cap (which will be the only baseball cap that children will be permitted to wear) and a new black 'Pegasus' coat (which will be optional, but is waterproof, with a hood, a reversible fleece lining and very good value). These items will be available directly from the manufacturer via a link on our website from the beginning of next term.





Mufti Day: The last day of term, Thursday 20th December, will be a Mufti Day. The children are welcome to wear their own clothes on this day. We are not asking for any money for this, but if parents want to make a donation to LUPUS UK, the collection box is in the office.

Medicines in school: Please remember that only medicines that have been prescribed by a doctor, with a label from the doctor on the bottle or box as evidence of this, can be administered in school. Unfortunately, any medicines bought 'over-the-counter' need to be given at home, and can not be given by school staff during the day. If your doctor thinks that your child has an on-going medical need for paracetamol, cough medicine and the like, they will happily write you a prescription and prescriptions are free of charge for children under 16 years of age.

**Extreme weather warnings:** We need to remind parents that in the event of extreme weather such as deep snow, it may be necessary to close the school. We will always endeavour to keep the school open but sometimes, if staff cannot get in to school or the site becomes unsafe, it may be necessary to close. We will inform parents of any closure by sending a text and by updating the school's website. Please ensure that your mobile number for the 'text to parents' service is up-to-date.
