PE kits

Please ensure your children have plimsolls, a white tee shirt and black shorts for PE lessons and these, along with all items of school uniform, are named. As the weather becomes colder, children can wear tracksuits when doing PE outside. Stud earrings are the only jewellery which can be worn at any time in school.

Nut allergies

We have a few children in school who have a severe nut allergy. If they were to eat, or in some cases even touch nuts, they could have a very serious or fatal reaction. For this reason we want to make our school a 'nut free zone' and are therefore asking all of you to ensure your child does not bring any food or drink into school which contains nuts. We do talk to the children and explain why it is so important that we are all 'nut aware'.

This is a special plea particularly to parents and carers whose children bring packed lunches. Although children in the dining hall are supervised and asked not to share food, they may occasionally offer something to a friend not realising how dangerous this could be. We realise that we could be stopping some children from bringing healthy items to school such as coconut juice or chewy nut bars but obviously we want to work together to ensure a child's life is not as risk.
