Update for Beulah Infant School

Dear Parents and Carers

As you know, in September Beulah Infant and Nursery School will become part of The Pegasus Academy Trust. The Trust is already responsible for three other successful local primary schools—Whitehorse Infants, Whitehorse Juniors and Ecclesbourne Primary School and we are looking forward to working with Beulah Infants next year. We have already been working hard thinking about how we might continue to improve the school and this newsletter contains updates on some changes we have already decided on from September. We know that working together in a group of schools makes all schools in the group stronger and we are confident that our involvement will help to raise standards and support the staff at Beulah Infants.

New school uniform. All schools within the Trust share a similar style of branding and so we have had to make some changes to the Beulah Infant school badge so that the pupils will feel part of the Pegasus 'family'. The new badge reflects the history of the area and refers to Beulah Spa, from which this part of Croydon and the school take their name. Research tells us that
