

Pupil Premium analysis 2014

Year 1 Phonics screening check- 91% pass for PPG, (compared to 63% nationally) 94% pass for non-PPG (compared to 78% nationally). A gap of 3 points, nationally this gap was 16 points in 2014.* Note that gaps are calculated from unrounded data.

| % more than expected progress | 48 (35) | 31 (33) | 44 (35) |
| Pupil Premium – expected progress | 91 (88) | 91 (91) | 100 (86) |
| PPG % more than expected progress** | 57 (34) | 35 (34) | 43 (38) |

** National figures are for non-disadvantaged children. This means that a greater proportion of PPG children made accelerated progress than the proportion of non-disadvantaged children nationally.
