ENGLISH	<u>Varjak Paw by SF Said</u> Children will study the above text about a cat that has to learn The Way and fight for himself. Through studying the book, children will write in a range of genres including newspaper articles, diary entries and first person accounts. They will also write their own extended, narrative version of the story They will focus on descriptive writing, punctuation, grammar, sentence structure and related spelling words and patterns.				<u>King Arthur stories including The Sword in the Stone.</u> Children will study the story of King Arthur which links to our thematic theme of the Anglo Saxons. They will also look at non-fiction and information texts about the time and use these to write their own version of a legend. They will focus on the features of good writing, using all the skills they have been taught so far in Year 4.	
MATHS	<u>Statistics</u> Children will study pictograms, bar charts and line graphs. They will learn how to interpret these and answer questions based on the data displayed.		<u>Position and direction</u> Children will be introduced to coordinates in the first quadrant. They will also learn to plot specific points to form polygons and describe movements between positions as translations of a given unit to the left, right, up or down.		<u>Measures</u> Children will solve practical measures problems involving length, weight and capacity. They will convert between measures and calculate using different units including £ and pence.	
SCIENCE	<u>Electricity</u> Investigation into circuits and their components.	<u>Electricity</u> Electrical conductors – what are they? What makes a good conductor?	<u>Electricity</u> Switches – what are they?
