ENGLISH	<u>The Demon Headmaster by Gillian Cross</u> Children will study the above text about a group of children who make a stand against their headmaster who wants to take over the world!. Through studying the book, children will write in a range of genres including newspaper articles, diary entries and first person accounts. They will also write their own extended, narrative version of the story focusing on descriptive writing, punctuation, grammar, sentence structure and related spelling words and patterns.				<u>Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl</u> Children will study the play script version of the classic Roald Dahl story. Through drama, role play and paired and group collaborative work they will explore the medium of play scripts and write their own scenes based on what they have learnt. They will focus on the features of good writing, using all the skills they have been taught so far in Year 4.	
MATHS	For the second half of the summer term, children will revisit areas of maths they have learnt about already this year. In some cases, such as in calculation, they will revise and refine their methods applying them to solve problems and preparing them for Year 5. They will also revisit certain topics, such as fractions, time and measures, to extend their knowledge of these areas of the curriculum.
