School closed for Polling Day on 29th November 2012: The school is being used as a polling station on 29th November 2012 and will be closed to pupils on this day. We apologise for any inconvenience. PLEASE NOTE, The Year 5 trip to the Museum of London will still go ahead as planned. Year 5 pupils should come into school for 9.00am, using the main entrance by the office, and are asked to wait in the DT area for their teachers.

Appointments and punctuality: If your child has a medical or dentistry appointment during the school day you are expected to bring evidence of this, such as an appointment card or hospital letter to show the office. In addition, please be aware that punctuality is monitored by our Educational Welfare Officer (EWO), in much the same way that attendance is. The school is open from 8.45am and the bell for registration goes at 9.00am. If a child is late, not seated in class when the 9.00am bell rings, they report to the office and it is our policy to ask for a reason, as this information is used by the EWO to decide what action to take if persistent lateness becomes an issue. If you do not feel that your child is able to verbally express a reason for their lateness, please accompany them to the office to tell Mrs Kissi or Mrs Soggee, our attendance officers, the reason yourself. It is also the schools' policy to send a text message home if a child has been late and to report punctuality on the end of year report.
