Head Lice

As with most schools, we occasionally find that we have 'visitors' in school. The Department of Health recommends a 'whole-school approach' to containing and controlling head louse transmission. This is where all the children in a school and other family members and contacts at home are checked and treated as necessary. To help parents deal with head lice, the Department of Health has produced the leaflet, '*The prevention and treatment of head lice*' which are available from their website or the school office. We would urge you to check your child's head regularly and treat where necessary. Please note, it is not necessary to keep your child off school for treatment and any absence as a result of head lice will be marked as unauthorised.
