The Pegasus Academy Trust is already responsible for three primary schools in Thornton Heath with 6 forms of entry—over 1000 children—in our care. We are now seeking approval from the government to open a secondary school in September 2014

The Pegasus Academy Trust was the first Primary Academy group approved by the Department for Education in Croydon in April 2011. In the 18 months since we were formed we have:

- Led Ecclesbourne Primary School out of Ofsted's "serious weaknesses" category. School now judged 'good' in a number of areas.
- Completed a £4.5M refurbishment at Ecclesbourne Primary School.
- Expanded our Whitehorse Manor schools from 2 to 3 forms of entry and worked with our partners to design wonderful new spaces to accommodate these children. This work is nearing completion.
- Been asked to create a new annexe for the Whitehorse Manor Schools on a site in Brigstock Road allowing more children the school place of their choice.

The Directors of the Pegasus Academy Trust are committed to providing a high quality of education in our part of Croydon and believe children should have the chance to go to a good local school. Unfortunately at present children have to travel some distance, often using public transport, to get to secondary school. Our vision is for a local secondary school for the children of Thornton Heath where they can get a similar high quality of education to that found at the other schools within the group. This school would:

- Carefully manage the move to secondary school with a 'bridge class' approach in Year 7, allowing students the chance to gain the study skills they will need and find their feet.
- Have a strong moral purpose but no business or religious affiliation.
- Specialise in humanities and citizenship—a choice unavailable locally.

Our values

In our existing schools we teach our children five core values.

- Are safe, healthy and happy;
- Have good manners;
- Strive to be independent learners;

Our new secondary school will continue to promote these values and we believe that we can deliver a different kind of school experience where students take far more responsibility for their own learning and are active participants both in the organisation of the school and in the local community. In our primary schools we have demonstrated high standards of behaviour and attainment over many years while remaining inclusive to children of all abilities. With the number of school age children in this part of the borough at an all time high we believe the time is now right to apply these same values in the secondary sector.
