Safeguarding- The children have been very busy learning about who helps us and how to keep safe. This week Year 1 and Year 2 had the NSPCC 'PANTS' assembly. The School Council decided to create and send out posters to ask our parents to help to keep the children safe by avoiding double parking and making 'u' turns outside of the school. Uniform: Can I just remind everyone that footwear should be black shoes or completely black trainers. There should be no other colours on footwear, including brand names and logos.
