Punctuality and attendance

The school opens at 8:45am. Any child who arrives after **9:00am** is late for school and **must be brought to the** office by a parent or carer where the lateness can be noted. Children should be collected promptly at 3:15pm by an adult who is known to us. If anyone different is going to collect your child please let us know. We will not let a child leave school with an adult we do not know. If your child is absent from school please record this on Studybugs or inform the office as soon as possible. Where possible we ask that you make medical appointments for your child outside of the school day. It is important for children to maximise their time in school so that they have the best outcomes. ## School Uniform and PE kits

On PE days the children are expected to wear their PE kits to school. They should still wear their school sweatshirt or jumper over their PE t-shirt. Now that the weather is getting colder, a pair of plain black jogging bottoms would be preferable to shorts. Please do not send your child in with non-uniform track suits. **Stud earrings** are the only jewellery, which can be worn at any time in school. I would like to remind you that if children wear boots to school then they need to change into black school shoes when they arrive. School shoes should be plain black. Brightly coloured footwear or white stripes/ticks on shoes etc is not part of the school uniform policy. We expect the children to be smart in their uniform at atll times.
