Dear Parents and Carers,

Strike action by members of the NEU on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March 2023

We are writing to inform you about strike action that is being taken by members of the National Education Union on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March and to advise you about arrangements for Whitehorse Manor Schools-Brigstock Site on that day.

Teachers and senior leaders who are members of the NEU will be on strike and Whitehorse Manor Schools-Brigstock Site **will be partially closed on these dates**. The arrangements for each class are as follows:

Whitehorse Manor Schools-Brigstock Site
Willow Class (Reception) – Open on 15 th & closed 16 th
Rowan Class (Yr1) – Open on 15 th & closed 16 th
Ash Class (Yr2) – Open on 15 th & closed 16 th
Elm class (Yr3) – Closed on 15 th & 16 th
Sycamore Class (Yr4) – Closed on 15 th & 16 th
Chestnut Class (Yr5) – Closed on 15 th & 16 th
Oak Class (Yr6) – Closed 15 th and open on 16 th

If your child's teacher is taking strike action and you have paid for wrap around care or activity clubs through the Pegasus Children's Club this will be credited to your account. All activity clubs are cancelled on Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March. Breakfast and After School Club will only be open for children whose classes are open.

We apologise unreservedly for the inconvenience this may cause many of you, and have endeavoured to inform you as early as possible so that you can make child care arrangements for the day.

We hope that you will appreciate that this a national dispute that cannot be resolved by staff on site. We know that teachers do not take strike action lightly and we all hope that this dispute can be properly resolved as quickly as possible so that there are no further disruptions to the education of the children at our school. We will update you on the arrangements for any subsequent strike action in due course.
