Second hand reading books

Weather permitting, we will be giving away reading books during the week of the 13th June at the end of the school day. These books are from reading sets and class reading corners that are no longer required in school. Please bring a bag and fill it up with free books to support your child's reading at home.

Punctuality and attendance

The school opens at 8:45am to allow children to filter in from this time. Any child who arrives after **9:00am** is late for school and must be brought to the office to be signed in by their adult. Children should be collected promptly at 3:15pm by an adult who is known to us. If anyone different is going to collect your child, please let us know. Children who are collected late delay staff from attending meetings, undertaking booster classes and interfere with staff members own childcare arrangements. If your child is absent from school, please inform the office as soon as possible by phone or email to brigadmin@pegasusacademytrust.org. Please note that if a child is absent due to **vomiting or diarrhoea**, then they cannot return to school for **48 hours** after the last bout. If your child tests positive for Covid they can return to school after 5 days of isolation as long as they are well enough to return to school.
