<u>Can you design your very own Mouse-</u> <u>Bird-Snake-Wolf puppets?</u>



Snake puppet

You will need:	Got it?
5 toilet roll tubes (or 3-4 kitchen roll	
tubes)	
Paint or colouring pens	
Dot stickers (if you have them)	
Thread or an old shoelace	
Red paper	
Cello tape	
2 lollypop sticks	



- 1. Paint / colour the tubes inside and out and leave to dry.
- 2. Cut the tubes in half and decorate with the stickers / pens.
- 3. Cut a long length of thread. Tie one end to one of the lolly sticks.
- 4. Thread the pieces of tube on to the string securing each in place with a piece of tape.
- 5. Tie the other end of the string to the second lolly stick.
- 6. Draw on two eyes to the end tube.
- 7. Cut a forked tongue from the red paper and tape to the head tube.

- 1. Paint or colour in your toilet roll tube
- 2. Draw a mouse head and cut out
- 3. Draw a pair of mouse ears and cut out
- 4. Stick the mouse ears onto the mouse head then stick this to the top of your toilet roll tube
- 5. Cut out three matchstick size strips of paper for the whiskers
- 6. Stick the whiskers together in a crisscross and stick to the head
- 7. Cut out a small circle and colour it pink for the mouse nose



Bird puppet

You will need:	Got it?
1 toilet roll tube	
Card or paper	
Paint or colouring pens	
Googly eyes or draw them on	
Feathers or large leaves. Have a look	
for some in your local park. Or get	
creative and draw a pair of wings	
Scissors	
Glue	



- 1. Paint or colour in your toilet roll tube
- 2. Using your paper or card, draw and cut out a bird face, eyes and beak
- 3. Stick the eyes and beak onto the face
- 4. Stick the whole face onto the toilet roll tube
- 5. Stick your wings (one on each side) to your toilet roll tube

Wolf puppet

You will need:	Got it?
A toilet roll tube	
Paint or colouring pens	
Scissors	
Glue	
Paper

- 1. Paint or colour in your toilet roll tube
- 2. Draw a pair of wolf ears, colour them in and cut them out
- 3. Stick your wolf ears to the top of your toilet roll tube
- 4. Draw a pair of wolf eyes and cut them out
- 5. Stick your wolf eyes onto your toilet roll tube
- 6. Draw a set of sharp white teeth and cut them out
- 7. Stick your scary teeth onto your toilet roll tube
