Dear Parents and Carers,

Normally, at this time of year the school would be gearing up for various festive events and our Nativity production. Children would be rehearsing their lines and learning their songs. Sadly, we won't be able to put a production together in quite the same way this year but we are working hard to come up with some sort of virtual performance that we can share with you. It won't be quite the same as usual but hopefully it can raise everyone's spirits and generate some communal festive cheer. Keeping everyone safe Once again, I would like to thank everyone who is helping to keep us all safe by following the procedures for dropping and collecting children and moving around the school grounds. We have introduced more temporary paving and standing areas to reduce the need for people to be close to each other. We have also installed additional scooter storage so that people do not have to walk around to the front of the school when dropping off in key stage one. Please do not linger when dropping your children. Again, please remember to keep your distance from staff and each other when collecting your children. To help reduce risk and to ensure we can keep the school open, staff are now wearing masks in communal areas and I would encourage you to wear a face mask on the school grounds. At the time of writing, I am pleased to say that we have had no positive cases in school and I am keen that we keep it that way. Please can I remind you that the school is closed to all visitors and nobody should be entering the school or dropping in to the office in any circumstances. <u>MAC vacancies</u> We currently have space for parents to join our Academy Council. Members of the Academy Council (MACs) play a vital role in offering support and challenge to the school leadership.
