In the sunny, bright afternoon they arrived at the starting point, "Fox can you be the umpire for the race?" asked Tortoise.

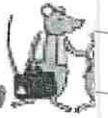
Fox replied "Yes I will, got to make sure the race is fair fair fair."

The calm Tortoise kept on troding along the race track.



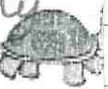
Eventually the Tortoise made it past Hare and ~~he~~ nearly finished.
