



Compare how Edward's feelings have changed during his journey.



Before

- Selfish and self centred - only cares about himself
- Vain - thought he was the best rabbit
- Didn't love Abilene as much as Abilene loved him
- He was the princess from the story that turns into a warthog

After

- Lonely
- Misses Abilene
- Wants to go back and have Abilene tell him stories.
- No longer a 'warthog'
- Doesn't need fancy things like his pocket watch anymore

Success criteria

Must use powerful adjectives, verbs and adverbs to describe Edward's feelings.

Remember to focus on his feelings and how Edward has changed.

For example: I used to be so *selfish* when I *lived* with you and I only *cared* about myself. Now that I'm *stranded* here in this *deserted, lonely* garden, I miss you all *terribly*.

Should use fronted adverbials.

Fronted adverbials tell us **how, when** or **where** something happened. They always have a comma at the end.

For example: *All day and night*, I think about Abilene and miss her. (**when**).

In the vegetable garden, crows are constantly disturbing me. (**where**)

Painfully, the wind whips across my face but the pain in my heart is worse. (**how**)

BYC use evidence from the text.

Use parts from the book in your letter. Can you talk about what has happened to Edward and use examples from the book to support this?

For example: Please believe me Pellegrina! I am not like the *self-centred princess* from the story and don't want to be an *ugly warthog*! I don't even care that I lost my shiny, gold *pocket watch*!
