

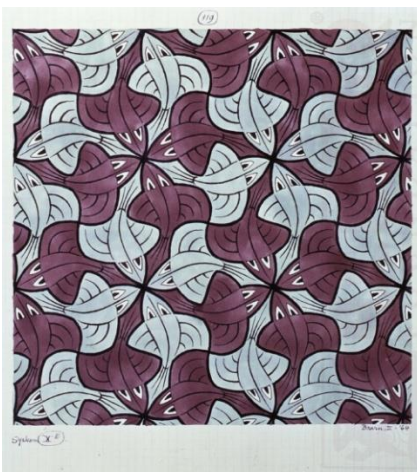
Art & Maths - M C Escher inspired tessellations

- A 10cm x 10cm square of card (could be from a cereal box or similar)
- A piece of paper
- Sellotape
- Colouring pencils/felt-tips (optional)

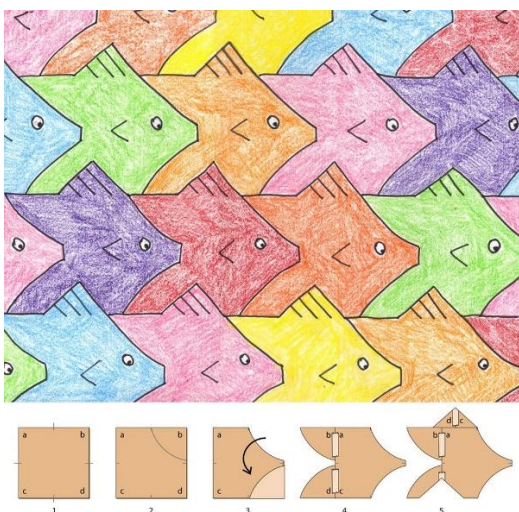
