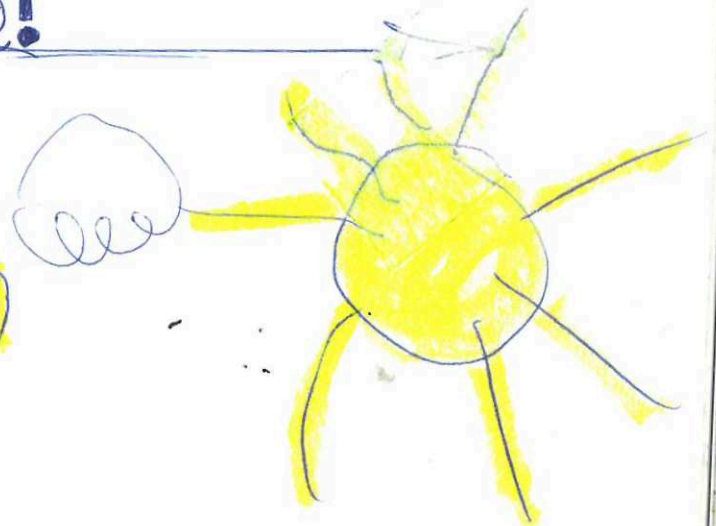

Oh mum's fall Don't want a leg in a cast!

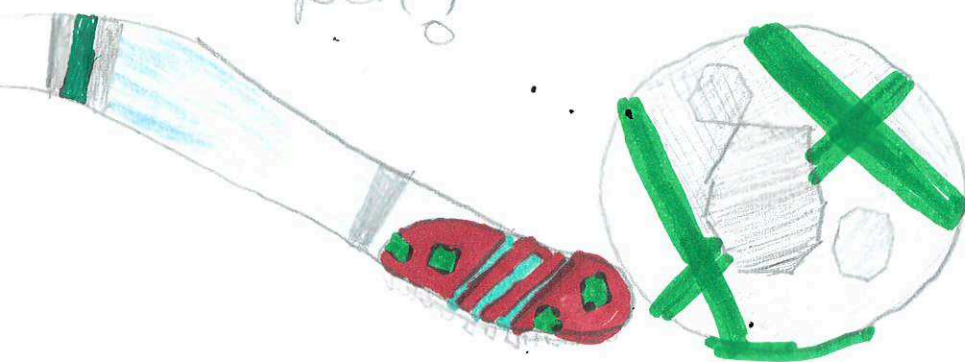
