In school:

- 1:1 reading with class teacher (CT) or teaching assistant (TA) every week, moving towards guided reading groups from the spring term which includes reading with the CT once a week

- Daily whole class story time
- Big books, 'Bug Club' and shared books used as part of class teaching
- Library time once a week
- CT monitoring reading diaries weekly

Home:

- 1x teacher choice book a week (chosen based on 1:1 reading with child)
- Daily 'Accelerated Reading' book from allocated book band (child's own choice)
- Library book (weekly, child's own choice)
- 'Bug Club' (allocated book band)
- Parent/carer to record in child's reading diary and sign weekly

Expectations for reading in Year 1

<u>In school:</u>

- Guided reading sessions daily, including reading with CT once a week
- Daily whole class story time
- Big books, 'Bug Club' and shared books used as part of class teaching
- Library time once a week
- Additional 1:1 reading or intervention, as appropriate
- CT monitoring reading diaries weekly

Home:

- 1x teacher choice book a week (chosen based on guided reading with child)
- Daily 'Accelerated Reading' book from allocated book band (child's own choice)
- Library book (weekly, child's own choice)
- 'Bug Club' (allocated book band)
- Parent/carer to record in child's reading diary and sign weekly

Expectations for reading in Year 2

In school:

- Guided reading sessions daily, including reading with CT once a week
- Reading comprehension texts, as part of class teaching
- Daily whole class story time
- Big books, 'Bug Club' and shared texts used as part of class teaching
- Library time once a week
- Additional 1:1 reading or intervention, as appropriate
- CT monitoring reading diaries weekly

Home:

- Daily 'Accelerated Reading' book from allocated book band (child's own choice)
- Library book (weekly, child's own choice)
- 'Bug Club' (allocated book band) or Oxford Owl e-books for children who have exceeded 'Bug Club'
- Parent/carer to record in child's reading diary and sign weekly
