## (To find out how many miles you walked, multiply the number of steps by 0.0005)

- Ask the adult you walk to school with to record how many steps you take on your journey to and from school from Monday 28th November – Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2022.
- 2. Record the amount of steps over the week, total them up and then hand the sheet back to your teacher.
- 3. We will record the child from each class who does the most steps on the STARS notice board!
