Dear Parents and Carers,

National Science & Engineering Week Competition 2023

The British Science Association is launching a nationwide poster competition for National Science and Engineering Week, on the theme of 'Connections'. You can make your poster on anything to do with this theme and you might like to have a look at some of the British Science & Engineering activity packs for some ideas. Inspiration can come from anywhere – innovation in technology or health care, or maybe even innovation that is used in STEM careers.

Posters can be created as a team (prizes will be split across the team) or individually and can include the following formats (entries should be created on one A4 or A3 piece of paper and **no** templates).

- Drawings
- Paintings
- Collages
- Graphic designs
- Please note – flaps are allowed on the poster as long as the poster still makes sense without the flaps being lifted (as a photo/scanned document will need to be submitted).

The following information **must** be on the back of your entry:

- First Name* (all names of team) and age (all ages if a team)
- Age category (of oldest team member) - (Early Years – Nursery/Reception, Infant – Year 1-Year 3, Junior – Year 4-Year 6)
- *Please note, the data submitted will be used for the administration of the competition. As first names, ages and schools of students may be shared on their website and social media pages, **before we send off the entries, we will change their name to a pseudonym (e.g. child A)** to protect their identity online. If their entry is one of the lucky ones, we will know who they are.
- **School Address – Atwood Primary School, Limpsfield Road, Sanderstead, South Croydon, CR2 9EE. Please do not put your home address on the entry.**

Entries will be shortlisted by members of the British Science Association and a panel of judges will select an overall winner in each category. Two runners up in each category will be uploaded to a Facebook page and the public will decide on a fifth 'popular vote' winner.

Here is the lowdown on what the judges will be looking for:

- **Creativity in approach** – Innovative angle on the content or creative interpretation of the theme
- **Content** – Clear, accurate and informative about a STEM topic
- **Effective communication** – presented and communicated in an engaging way

Entries must be sent to myself via the office by **Wednesday 29th March 2023** to give me enough time for them to be sent. Either bring the poster in or take a photo/scan the document. Please remember to include the relevant information on the back of your entry or in the email.
