Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Day Arrangements – Year 1 – Year 6 Thursday 22nd June

It's that time of year once more and I am writing to provide you with information about our annual Sports Day. As ever, the wonderful team of SAS Coaches will be supporting the children to get stuck in all day.

The children will be competing in their Houses, so Fire (Red), Earth (Green), Water (Blue) and Air (Yellow)your child should therefore come to school in the appropriate Atwood PE kits but wearing their house colour. Please ensure that your child does not wear any jewellery, have their hair tied up if it is long, wears a cap and comes to school wearing factor 50 sun screen. The field is very open and a day in the sun can lead to sun burn.

As in previous years, the children will take part in a Multi Sports Carousel of different activities earning points for their team.

Over lunchtime, the children will enjoy a picnic on the field, and either sit with you as a parent or carer, sit with another nominated family, or sit with their class teacher or TA.

After lunch, there will be a variety of running races and other exciting events. Now is the time to start training for the Mums' Race, the Dads' Race and the Toddler's Race!

The afternoon will culminate in the presentation of the Trophies and of course, the raising of the House Flag. Who will win this year?

Other useful information for you: the toilets will be the portaloos on the field- there will be no access for parents, carers and relatives to our indoor toilets. Remember to bring a picnic rug and a chair if you want to.

If you plan to join your child for the picnic, please provide them with a picnic lunch. If you are unable to attend, you may either provide your child with a picnic lunch, or request a school picnic lunch, payable via Magic Booking for Junior children. Your child can eat with their teacher and class or with a nominated parent/carer (please see reply slip).

Access to the school field will be via the side gate of the Children's Centre to your left as you come through the school gates. You are welcome to bring along blankets and chairs. When children arrive on the field they will wait with their teacher until they are collected by a parent/carer. If you are unable to attend, your child will eat lunch on the field with the rest of their class or nominated parent.

Remember that there is no photography or filming during the entire event.

	Parents stand on the side of the track with backs to the school.
	Children will be seated in classes on the opposite side under the trees for shade.
