Nursery Newsletter: Summer 1, 2025

Welcome back for another exciting half term! We have loved hearing about what all the children have been up to over the Easter break! As we enter the summer term, we are hoping for some lovely weather to enjoy our outside area. Our topic this half term is **'The Wheels On the Bus'** where the children will focus on different types of transport and travelling. This topic includes stories, poems and some great sing along songs!

Communication & Language: Over the next half term, we will be focussing on remembering stories and being able to recall main events. When recalling events from the stories, we will work on using full sentences and encourage the children to retell stories to each other. We will also be using actions to support the children in their recall of the story and use these actions to perform the stories to each other. In the classroom there will be lots of small worlds set up to show a variety of modes of transport including trains, buses, cars and boats. The children can use these to retell the stories they have heard and create their own journeys using language they have learnt. We will also encourage the children to draw maps around different areas and explain what the maps are showing.

Personal, Social and Emotional: As we enter the final full term, before the children move up to reception, we will be encouraging them to resolve their own conflicts and disagreements. We will be working on how to communicate with others if you are upset and looking at ideas about how issues can be resolved before asking a grown up for help. A daily focus will be looking for children that are able to share effectively and communicate their needs to those around them.

Physical Development: This half term, we will continue to support the children towards improving their pencil grip. We will work with them to begin copying parts of their name and they will have lots of opportunities in the classroom to practise letter formation. We will do this through fine motor activities each day involving play dough, tweezers, threading and pegs. To develop gross motor skills, we will continue to look at ball skills but also explore different ways of moving. Using our different modes of transport, we will think about how they would move and set up tracks/maps for the children to navigate as their chosen transport.

Literacy: This half term, we will be looking at a variety of texts focussed around transport. Including 'The Big Red Bus' and 'The Train Ride'. When looking at each new text we will be focussing on new vocabulary, encourage discussions and support the children in answering questions related to the story. We will be exploring lots of activities relating to the stories around the classroom and fully will immerse the children in the text. We will be building on the children's sound awareness as we go into the Summer term and continue to introduce a sound each week. We focus on the identification of this sound at the beginning of words but not the recognition of the grapheme itself. We will set up lots of activities in our provision to encourage sound awareness and identification but also oral blending. The sounds we will be looking at this term are f, l, j and v.

Mathematics: In maths this half term we will be covering a variety of topics. We will expand the children's knowledge of numbers to 5 working on formation, problem solving and subitising. Subitising is the ability to look at a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many objects there are without needing to count. Within shape, we will recap 2D shapes and begin to introduce the concept of 3D shapes and how the two are different. We will also be looking at positional language with the children and use this when setting up small worlds and through their play in the outside area.

Understanding the World: When looking at different modes of transport this half term we will also look at different occupations that operate the transport. This could include, train drivers, farmers, astronauts, bus drivers etc. We will talk about what their job involves and how many of them help us in our day to day lives. Through this we will also touch on other occupations that use transport to support their work such as police officers and paramedics.

Expressive Arts and Design: When looking at transport this half term we will also be focussing on building different modes of transport using our junk modelling resources. We will work with the children to think about the size of boxes they are using, how we can represent the different moving parts and how we can attach each part together in the most effective way. We are sure you are going to love some of our creations!
