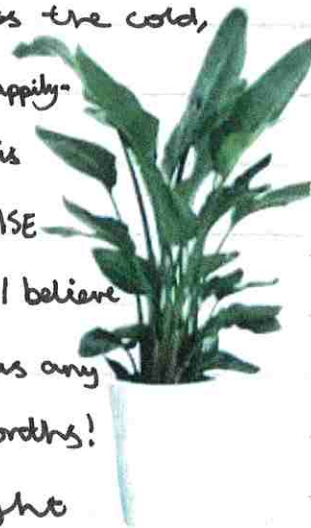


Dear Sir/Madam,
