### Punctuality and attendance

The school opens at 8:45am. Any child who arrives after **9:00am** is late for school and **must be brought to the office by a parent or carer where the lateness can be noted**. Children should be collected promptly at 3:15pm by an adult who is known to us. If anyone different is going to collect your child please let us know. We will not let a child leave school with an adult we do not know. If your child is absent from school please record this on Studybugs or inform the office as soon as possible. Where possible we ask that you make medical appointments for your child outside of the school day. It is important for children to maximise their time in school so that they have the best outcomes. ### Contact details

Now that the weather is colder, a pair of plain black jogging bottoms would be preferable to shorts. Please do not send your child in with non-uniform track suits.

These are taking place on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March. There is an expectation that parents attend Parents' Evening. Parents' Evening is an opportunity to look at your child's work and for staff to share with you how your child is doing.

On **Monday 2nd March**, to start Book Week, children can come to school dressed as their favourite book character or in their favourite Pyjamas. A school Book Fair will be held in the Hall before and after school the week commencing 9th of March. More details will follow.
