

# Whitehorse Manor Infant School Friday 15th September 2023



Welcome back! It has been a busy and very sunny start to the term but the children have all settled well into their new classes and made a good start to the year. It is lovely to see all the children returning to school and hear all their news.

Many thanks to all the parents who have followed the guidance on school uniform and shoes; the children coming back look so smart and it creates a very positive feel in the school. We have moved to a paperless communication system this year and this newsletter will be the first of the year and the last to be sent out on paper. If you have not yet signed up to **Studybugs** please do so ASAP. This is the new attendance reporting system and the portal by which we will share communications about trips, events and important dates and letters. You can download the **Studybugs App** onto your mobile phone. We are always working on improving our communications to parents and if you sign up to Studybugs you should never miss a letter or important communication again! Class teachers can help you with Studybugs if you need some support.

**Attendance:** Unfortunately, we have had a higher than usual unauthorised absent rate upon our return to school. Therefore, we are tracking unauthorised absence rigorously moving forwards. If there is a very good reason that your child cannot attend school, you are expected to request exceptional leave before your child is absent from school. Any request for exceptional leave which comes after the period of absence has already been taken **will not** be granted and will be classed as unauthorised absence. The office is always available by email if you are unable to call or come into the office in person for any reason. Any absence that is attached to a school holiday, no matter the reason for the exceptional leave request, **is likely to be denied** and will be classed as unauthorised absence. There has been a significant rise in vague 'family emergencies' that are attached to a holiday, when we are all aware that flights are cheaper. In order to ensure fairness, and without having to ask intrusive questions, it is easier to expect that requests which are attached to a holiday will not be authorised. Parents can be issued a fixed penalty notice of £60 per child, per parent by the Attendance Officer for extended unauthorised absence. We have issued 6 this week.

### **Birthdays:**

Due to the high number of food allergies in our school, we will only give out birthday bags, which contain **non-food** items. Our preference would be a book donation for the class to share to celebrate a child's birthday. This is also a much cheaper outlay for families.

## **Charity Events:**

We are supporting the following charities this term- Jeans for Genes on Friday 22nd September. Children can wear jeans to school on this day and bring £1 to donate to this charity. We will be holding a raffle and cake sale to raise money for Macmillan on Friday 29th September. Any donations of new unwanted gifts e.g. toiletry sets, scented candles etc. or new unwanted toys would be welcomed to help raise money in our raffle for this worthy charity. Please drop them at the school office. We will also be collecting non-perishable food gifts for Harvest. Details will follow at a later date. We hope that families can support these charities.
