## Year 2 Trip to London - Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024

As part of our exciting 'Looking at London' work this term, we are learning about the Great Fire of London in our history work and about famous London landmarks in geography. On **Tuesday 5th March 2024** we will be taking the children to St Dunstan's in the East, a church which was greatly damaged during the Great Fire, but had significant rebuilding work designed by Christopher Wren. We will also be visiting Pudding Lane, where the fire started. Finally, we will visit 'The Monument', which was built to commemorate the Great Fire of London and to celebrate the rebuilding of the city after the fire. The website gives you information on where we will be going -

http://www.themonument.info/. The children will also get the chance to walk across London Bridge to see views of the Thames and all the landmarks along the river. There will be no cost for this trip. Children will return to school for 3:30pm.
