



Safeguarding and Child Protection Information Leaflet for Children

What does safeguarding and child protection mean?

- At The Pegasus Academy Trust, all of the adults around you think your health, safety and wellbeing are very important
- We want to keep you safe and help you know your rights and how to protect them
- We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourselves and stay safe



How will the staff at school protect you?

- We provide a safe environment for you to learn in
- We want to ensure that you remain safe at home as well as at school
- We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something

Who will help you at school?

- We have Designated Safeguarding Leads. They are trained to help children and adults if they are really worried about something. If there is something worrying you about school or home, you or your parents and teachers can speak to one of them
- Remember, you can talk to any adult in school if you are worried about something but they may have to tell a Designated Safeguarding Lead for your safety
